100% Malbec.

Full moon of March 20, 2019.
- **Harvest**  
Hand harvested, in small plastic boxes of 18 kg.
- **Average vineyard production**  
8,000 kg per ha - 3,2 tons per acre - 61 hl/ha
- **Fermentation**  
Alcoholic in stainless steel tanks.
- **Alcohol**  
14.8°.
- **TA / VA / PH / R. Sugar**  
5.76 / 0.43 / 3.70 / -1.83 grs
- **Types of oak and length time in bottle**  
6 months in used French oak barrels and 6 months in the bottle before release.
- **Production**  
14,677 bottles.
